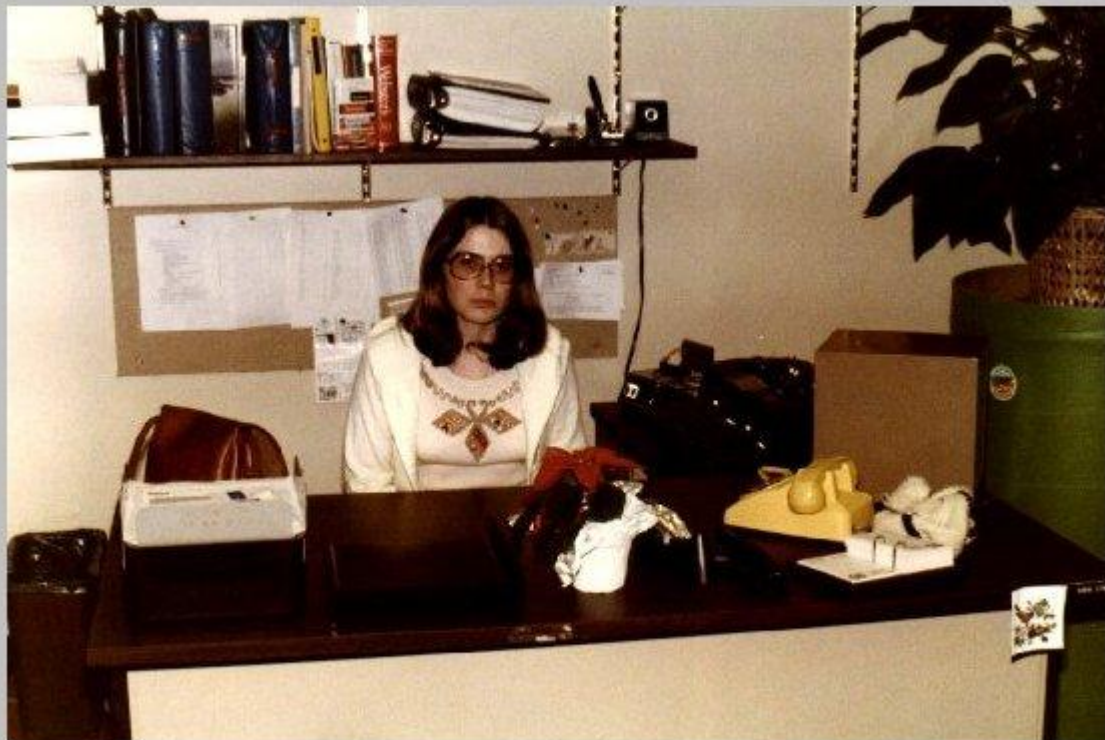
Leann and Suzi were irreplaceable Switchboard Operators!



Gail (Boom Boom) Callaway ran the Word Processing Center with efficiency and personal charm.



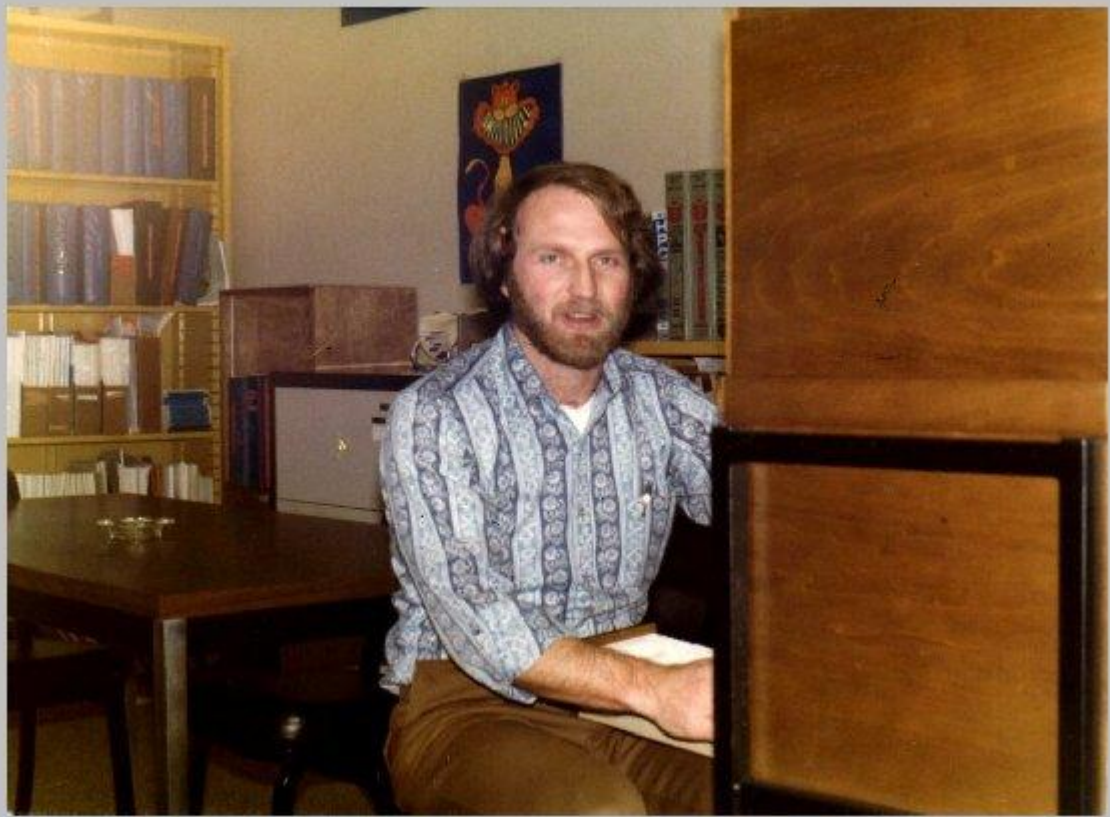

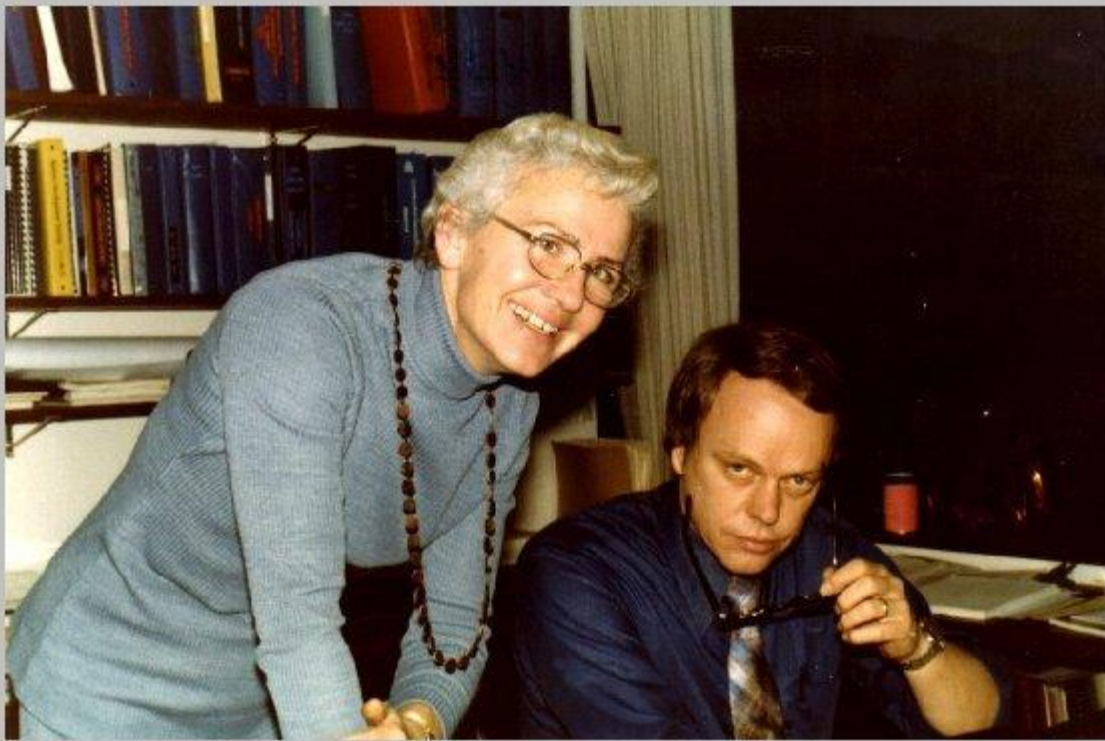

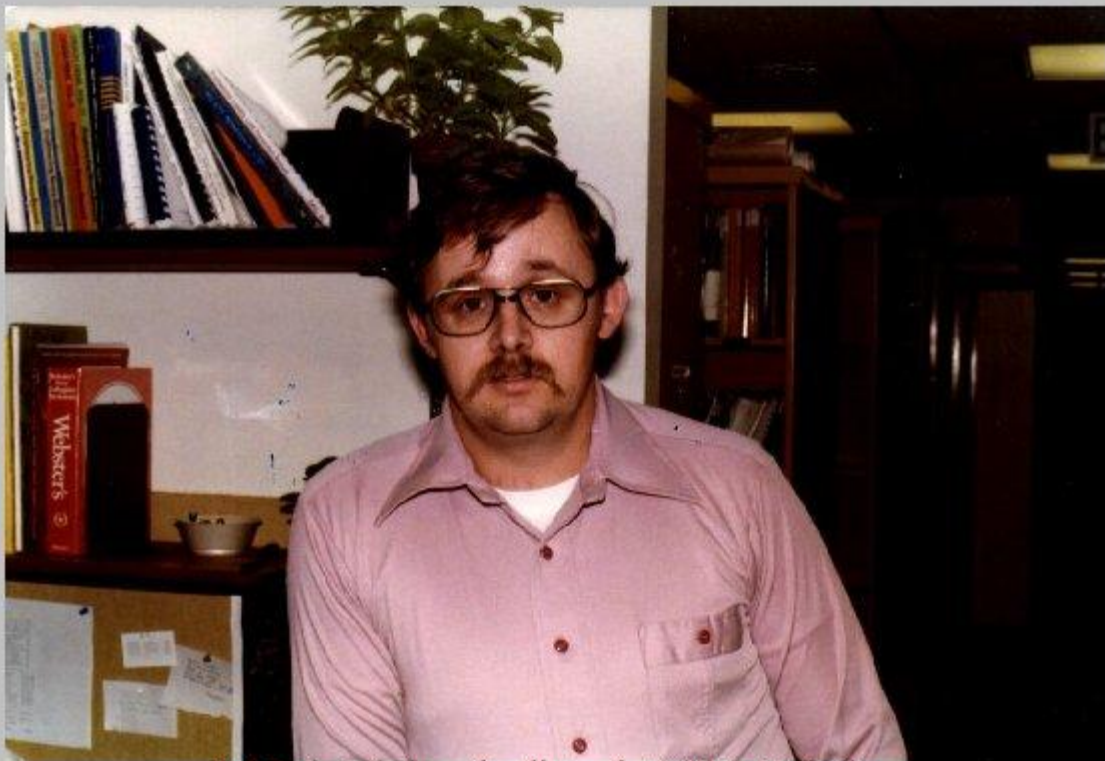
Meet Pam Estby, the efficient librarian.

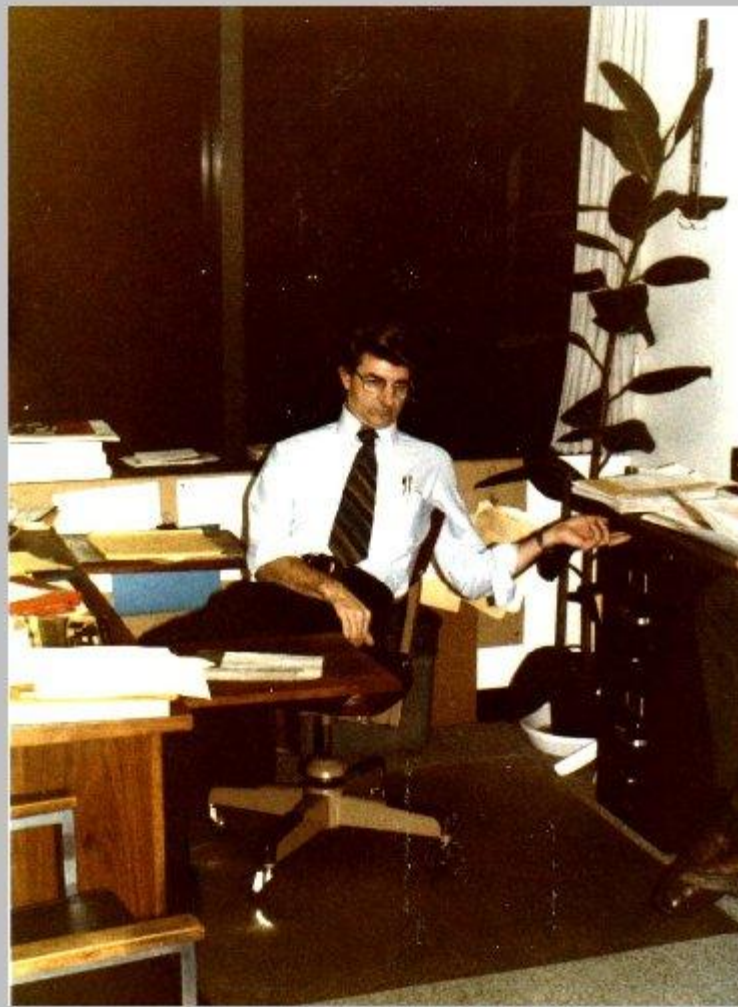
